

How to View Our *Southnaz Webcast*

Welcome to **Southnaz Webcast!** At South Church of the Nazarene in Lansing, Michigan, we have begun broadcasting our morning worship service live over the internet! We call this new ministry, the “**Southnaz Webcast.**” Our webcast service begins at 10:50 a.m. each Sunday Morning. In addition, the last several services are archived and available for viewing “**On Demand.**”

To view the webcast or any archived service, go to the following url in any internet browser on your computer. You will need DSL or Broadband internet service for best results.

The screen that appears will look very much like the one below. Please be aware that the cost of these broadcasts is supported by advertisements. When you first connect, there will be a 15 second video ad. Then during the broadcast, from time to time there will also be an ad that shows up in a narrow stripe at the bottom of the screen. The distraction of these is minimal.

Please note the small white button named “**ON-AIR**”, and right beside it the darker “**ON-DEMAND**” button below our church logo. When you first get to this website, the screen will be all snow until the connection is complete. This may take several seconds. Then either a default screen like that above or the online service will begin showing.

Viewing On-Demand Archived Videos

Whether the service is being broadcast at the time you are watching or not, you may click on the “**ON-DEMAND**” button at any time. When you do, the broadcast screen will become smaller and beside it will be a list of archived videos of previous services, as shown in the picture below.



You may click on any of the displayed “listed” services to begin watching the video. If you want to stop watching the selected video and choose another, simply click on the black square on the left side of the **ON-DEMAND** button. While the selected video is playing, the screen will look similar to the picture below:



Notice that the red arrow above points to a control bar from which you can control the **playback** of the video. You can **pause** the video by clicking the ► symbol. You may also **fast forward**, or browse quickly through the video by clicking at the beginning of the

black bar and dragging it to the left or right. The **sound level** may be adjusted by clicking the + and – symbols next to the speaker symbol.

When selecting videos from the “On-Demand” menu, there may be too many videos to view at one time, in which case there will be a scroll bar on the right which you can use to scroll through the available videos.

We hope you will enjoy both the “live” and “archived” broadcasts of South Church of the Nazarene.
