**PASTOR AND SHEILA DeMOTT**



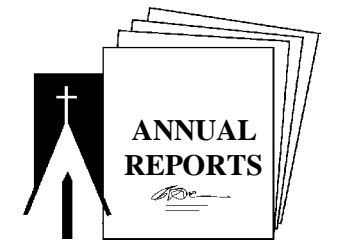

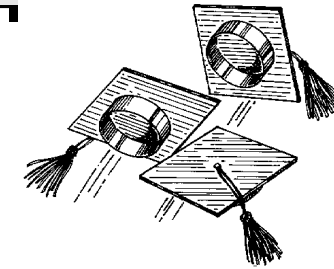
